

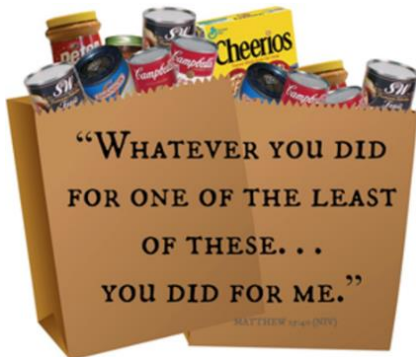

Please place all packages in the baskets located in the foyer. *Any food or items you wish to donate are welcome any month.*

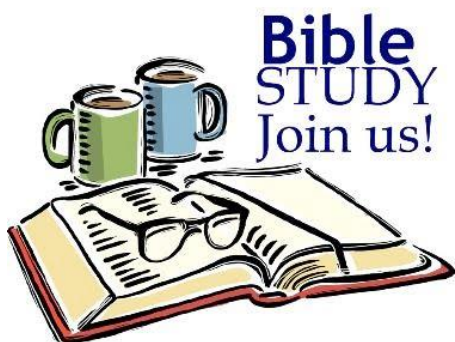
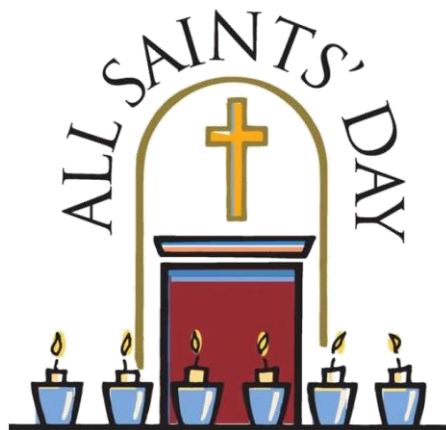
ALL SAINTS SUNDAY – October 30
